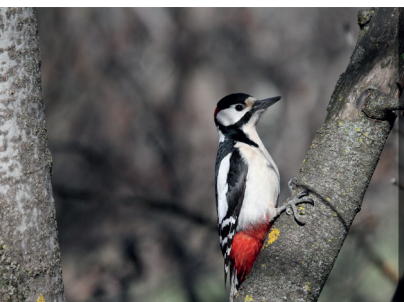


SONIC EXPERIENCE ROOM

Here, sight is unnecessary, and the eyes can finally rest. In this hall, only hearing is required: eight stations isolate you from all external noises and transport you to a timeless place, animated only by the sounds of nature. Birdsong, animal calls, the wind's whisper, the gurgle of water... A journey into an indefinite time where no human-made noise disturbs the incredible interplay and blending of nature's voices.



FAUNA ROOM

The journey concludes in the hall housing the collection of taxidermied animals that the Touring Club collected in this place starting from the 1960s to offer an image of the fauna of the Alpine arc. On one wall, a continuous cycle projection is dedicated to the animals inhabiting the territory of the Grigne.

GROUND FLOOR

INFO POINT

An information point at the entrance of the structure welcomes visitors, providing useful directions for the visit, brochures, and informative materials.

TERRITORY ROOM

A continuous cycle projection animates a relief model, allowing visitors to orient themselves in the territory of the Grigne and Piani Resinelli. Next to the relief model, a looping video introduces visitors to the peaks, ridges, spires, and walls where generations of climbers have tested their skills. The relief model displays the paths (among the most frequented in the entire Alps), the location of shelters, and bivouacs. The video introduces various outdoor activities that can be practiced in the area.

MOUNTAINEERING ROOM

On a multi-touch table, visitors can browse, enlarge, and "interrogate" valuable historical and contemporary images, telling the stories of routes, walls, and climbers who have made history in mountaineering in the Grigne. The virtual journey begins by walking along the beautiful Direttissima trail, a path that winds through the incredible universe of steep meadows and fantastical limestone pinnacles. Other images recount the stories of ten climbers who left indelible marks on the Grigne. These individuals symbolize a passion that has led climbers from Lecco to the most beautiful and challenging mountains in the world, rising above the lake.

THE ROOMS OF WONDERS

Villa Gerosa Museum House makes its informative and documentary material accessible in a simple and engaging way, thanks to the new setup.

The rooms feature multimedia devices, and the visiting route is based on interactivity and thematic and spatial continuity with the splendid environment in which the villa is located: the Parco del Valentino at Piani dei Resinelli, at the foot of the Southern Grigna.

The vast natural and historical heritage of the Grigne comes to life for visitors through videos, sound experiences, and multi-touch tables that allow them to "move around" within this extraordinary environment, discovering and analyzing its conformation, characteristics, and history.

FIRST FLOOR

PROJECTION ROOM

The hall welcomes visitors with a large screen projecting continuous cycle films dedicated to the territory and mountaineering. Among these are video interviews collected and preserved in the MODiSCA (MONTagne di SCAtti) archive featuring iconic figures of climbing in the Grigne, from those known worldwide like Walter Bonatti to others less known but still genuine expressions of local alpine culture and tradition.

FLORA ROOM

The hall offers an immersive experience that reflects the violently vertical dimension of the Grigne, with limestone towers seemingly embedded in steep meadows, and of the part of the Parco del Valentino overlooking Lake Como, where impressive cliffs plunge for 1000 meters to the lake's shores. With a touch on the interactive lectern, visitors can access cards dedicated to the protected flora of Resinelli and the Grigne and learn about the historical figures who played a leading role in botanical exploration of the area.
